

SSA Terms, Conditions & Refund Policy

SSA has the right to dismiss or refuse admission to students/attendees that are not in compliance with the Terms and Conditions and Policies listed below.

1. SSA will review samples of prospective students work prior to accepting an application.
2. All paid tuition is non-refundable and non transferable this includes all SSA classes, workshops and programs. Non-Transferable means: that no one can attend on your behalf; your registration cannot be transferred to anyone else; you cannot transfer your tuition payments to another program, workshop, class or date. Sorry no exceptions.
3. All class fees are due 14 days prior to the commencement of the given class.
4. If SSA cancels any class, workshop or program, whether fully or partially, full tuition or a portion thereof, will be refunded to the registrant for any and all remaining cancelled days or portion of days. Refunds will be provided in 30 days. If SSA reschedules any class, workshop, or program within 30 days of the originally scheduled class, tuition will be applied and credited toward the rescheduled class. If SSA reschedules any class, workshop, or program more than 30 days after the original scheduled date, a full refund can be requested and will be paid in 30 days.
5. You must have SSA's consent to advertise classes, workshops or events for other institutions or teachers. Solicitation for other programs, schools and workshops is not permissible.
6. SSA reserves the right to post copies of student's artwork or to use student/attendee photograph for program publicity.
7. SSA reserves the right to photograph and video all Demos and Lectures. All photographs, video and audio recordings of SSA workshop sessions are Copyright by the Sevenfold School of Art and may not be sold, distributed or reproduced without written consent of SSA.
8. SSA will notify models if their images have been photographed or taped. Model images will not be published without prior notice.
9. Student/Attendee agrees that they will not video/audio tape the sessions by using video camera, digital camera, cell phone or computers. See also SSA's *Student Code of Conduct*.
10. For the security and respect of the models, teachers and students, student/attendee may not photograph the model in the classroom.
11. Cell phones need to be turned off and put away during all SSA sessions.
12. SSA is not responsible for lost or stolen articles during SSA classes, programs and workshops.
13. Student/Attendee agrees that SSA is not liable for any injury physical or mental.
14. SSA accepts no responsibility for any student loss associated with unrecoverable travel costs or reservations.
15. If models cancel their agreement with SSA. Then SSA will hire a replacement model.
